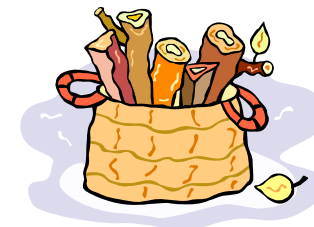
## **GARBAGE CONTAINERS**
